The UWF unit meeting is March 14 at 1:00 in the church parlor with Marilyn Taylor presenting the Prayer and Self Denial Program. This is one of the five areas of mission giving we support. The following is an article from the recent Conference newsletter submitted by Ingrid Cook, our Conference Education and Interpretation Coordinator:

“ ...our mission dollars change the lives of women and children. The dollars we give help our regional missionaries promote programs on specific topics of training. Through our pledge dollars the mission of United Women in Faith becomes reality in the areas of spiritual formation, leadership development, fellowship and education.

....We gave scholarships to 192 students in the United States and around the world, totaling over \$410,000.

....More than 400,000 meals were provided by our national mission institutions.

....We took 7,748 legislative actions for climate justice online.

....718 children, youth and women in the Philippines, Nepal, India and Myanmar were served in 2022 through targeted programs.

....Women in Banaybanay, Philippines are directly involved in making peanut butter and later trained other women.”

These are just a few of the areas our mission dollars were highlighted in the 2023 and 2024 editions of RESPONSE MAGAZINE.

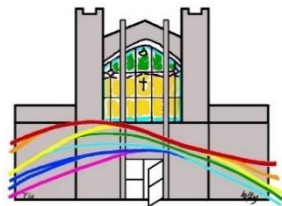

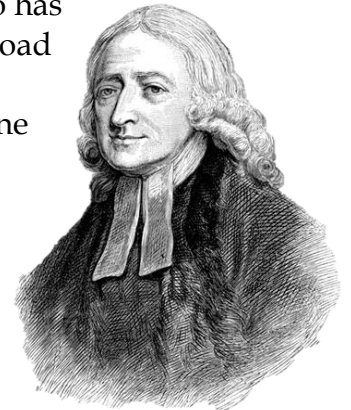

## Lamb of God performance

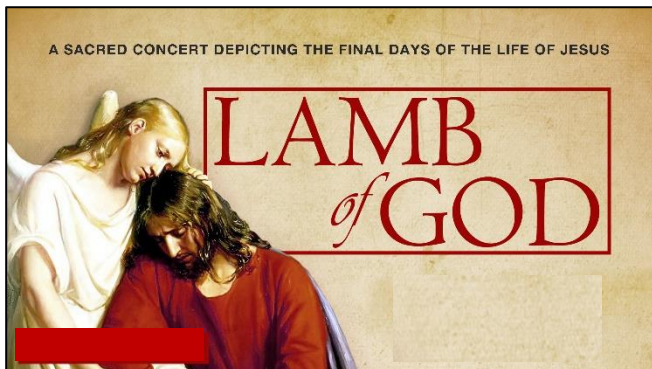
