7 A Covenant Prayer in the Wesleyan Tradition

I am no longer my own, but thine.

Homeless Services

In July there were 147 homeless services supplied in the 17 days we were open. This represented services to 48 unique persons. The services provided included 131 showers, 33 loads of laundry, and 9 requests for supplies. The supplies included emergency food, hygiene kits, socks, underwear, gas, mail, dog food and WIFI. The clients ranged in age from 19 to 74 with an average age of 47.5. Time in the church varied from 2 min to 276 minutes with an average of 49 minutes. 17 visitors were new clients for us. 75% have cellphones and 90% had valid ID.

Vika was a blessing to Joe and he loved her deeply, striving to better their life together. He was a wonderful husband and father.

Joe loved snowboarding, fishing, camping, traveling, music, and especially sharing good food with family and friends. Beloved by all who knew him, he could be spontaneous, but was also a planner. He was motivated for success by his goals and had the matching potential for all his dreams.

Joe was preceded in death by his oldest sister, Alicia Anne and his mother, Merilee

Haga. Joe is survived by his wife Victoria; step-son, Keith; father, Roger; and sister, Lora (James) King.
