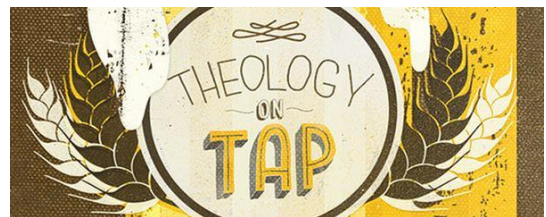
## Are you still waiting for your stimulus check?
