Theme for the day: "Things Aren't Always What They Look Like"

Sermon title: "What's Going On Here?"

LESSON FROM HEBREW SCRIPTURE
(Joel 2:23-32)

Fear not, Earth! Be glad and celebrate! God has done great things. Fear not, wild animals! The fields and meadows are greening up. The trees are bearing fruit again: a bumper crop of fig trees and vines! Children of Zion, celebrate! Be glad in your God. Never again will my people be despised.

The Sun will turn black and the Moon blood-red

"And that's just the beginning: After that – "I will pour out my Spirit on every kind of people. Your sons will prophesy, also your daughters. Your old men will dream, your young men will see visions. I'll even pour out my Spirit on the servants, men and women both. I'll set wonders in the sky above and signs on the earth below: Blood and fire and billowing smoke, the sun turning black and the moon blood-red. Before the Judgment Day of God, the Day, tremendous and awesome. Whoever calls, 'Help, God!' gets help. On Mount Zion and in Jerusalem here will be a great rescue – just as God said. Included in the survivors are those that God calls."

LESSON FROM THE CHRISTIAN GOSPEL
(Luke 18:9-14)

Jesus told his next story to some who were complacently pleased with themselves over their moral performance and looked down their noses at the common people: "Two

men went up to the Temple to pray, one a Pharisee, the other a tax man. The Pharisee posed and prayed like this: 'Oh, God, I thank you that I am not like other people – robbers, crooks, adulterers, or, heaven forbid, like this tax man. I fast twice a week and tithe on all my income.'

"Meanwhile the tax man, slumped in the shadows, his face in his hands, not daring to look up, said, 'God, give mercy. Forgive me, a sinner.'"

Jesus commented, "This tax man, not the other, went home made right with God. If you walk around with your nose in the air, you're going to end up flat on your face, but if you're content to be simply yourself, you will become more than yourself."
