## LESSON FROM HEBREW SCRIPTURE (Joel 2:23-32)

Fear not, Earth! Be glad and celebrate! God has done great things. Fear not, wild animals! The fields and meadows are greening up. The trees are bearing fruit again: a bumper crop of fig trees and vines! Children of Zion, celebrate! Be glad in your God. Never again will my people be despised.

The Sun will turn black and the Moon blood-red

"And that's just the beginning: After that— "I will pour out my Spirits on every kind of people: Your sons will prophesy, see also your daughters. Your old men will dream, your young men will see visions. # LESSON FROM THE CHRISTIAN GOSPEL (Luke 18:9-14)

Jesus told his next story to some who were complacently pleased with themselves over their moral performance and looked down their noses at the common people: "Two men went up to the Temple to pray, one a Pharisee, the other a tax man. The Pharisee posed and prayed like this: 'Oh, God, I thank you that I am not like other people—robbers, crooks, adulterers, or, heaven forbid, like this tax man. I fast twice a week and tithe on all my income.'

"Meanwhile the tax man, slumped in the shadows, his face in his hands, not daring to look up, said, 'God, give mercy. Forgive me, a sinner.'"

Jesus commented, "This tax man, not the other, went home made right with God. If you walk around with your nose in the air, you're going to end up flat on your face, but if you're content to be simply yourself, you will become more than yourself."
