## **Parsonage Project**

Now that the Trinity parsonage is not being used, a decision was made to fix it up and rent it out with the proceeds going to pay apportionments. The trustee team accomplished this with the help of a property manager and the July rent check of \$1,620 is being sent in as apportionments.

The effort to get the parsonage ready to rent cost about \$4,500 which is not bad since we have not put money into the parsonage for the 9 years that it was in use. The fixup included:

- 1. Rekey the doors
- 2. Haul the junk out
- 3. Clean the carpets
- 4. Restore the landscaping, mow, trim, cut bushes
- 5. House cleaning service
- 6. Replace downstairs bedroom carpet
- 7. Power bill for 6/30 to 7/20
- 8. Replace cracked window in dining room
- 9. Repair the sprinkler system
- 10. Replace 7 smoke detectors

After the fixup the parsonage is valued at about \$354,000. The trustees had to verify the church's insurance policy would still cover the building as a rental and that the assessor's office was aware it was no longer exempt from property tax. The parsonage is rented out until June 30, 2024, when it might be used again to house a pastor.

# **Sanctuary Restoration**

One of the joys of being the curators of a 107-year-old church building on the National Register of Historic Places is that normal repairs become restoration. We are so fortunate to have Rob who has become a master at working to restore the plaster over brick and lath and plaster ceilings used 107 years ago in building our church. Rob is now working at the 15-foot level building up the surface thickness where 107 years of paint thickness have peeled off. When he has restored the thickness and texture of the wall surface it will get a primer coat and a finish coat of paint. The north side of the sanctuary will be next.

#### **Homeless Services**

In July there were 147 homeless services supplied in the 17 days we were open. This represented services to 48 unique persons. The services provided included 131 showers, 33 loads of laundry, and 9 requests for supplies. The supplies included emergency food, hygiene kits, socks, underwear, gas, mail, dog food and WIFI. The clients ranged in age from 19 to 74 with an average age of 47.5. Time in the church varied from 2 min to 276 minutes with an average of 49 minutes. 17 visitors were new clients for us. 75% have cellphones and 90% had valid ID.

# **Apportionment Payment Made**



For many years Trinity has been struggling to pay apportionments to the Idaho-Oregon Annual Conference. Apportionments are the "United" part of United Methodist church. Apportionments go to support the Sage district office, the programs from the Oregon-Idaho conference offices, programs from the nationwide UMC, conference leadership and the bishop's leadership team. Select "Idaho Falls: Trinity" from the pulldown menu.

Trinity's share of the apportionments for 2023 is \$25,906. The July rent check from the parsonage (\$1,620) is being sent in as apportionments. The plan is to make \$8,700 in apportionment payments from rent checks by the end of the year.

## **Real Talk~From Pastor Kathy**

People younger than me have an expression they use these days: "real talk." Real talk, as opposed to small talk, is conversation or writing that gets right to the point with no fussing around. I'd like to share some real talk with you in this article. Normally, as the new pastor I would ease into sharing the information below, but we don't have time for such small talk. It's got to be real talk, right now.

The situation we find ourselves in is that United Methodist ministry in Idaho Falls has reached a crossroads. If we continue to do what we are doing, and nothing else, there will be no United Methodist ministry in Idaho Falls in just a few years. I won't list a bunch of statistics here (please come to the Aug. 10 meeting to hear the details) but the truth is our congregations do not have a lot of time left to continue the ministry they are engaged in right now. The advanced age of our congregants, and the lack of people under 40 years of age, are the most obvious signs that we are facing shortened lifespans as viable churches. Less obvious is the fact that our ways of expressing of the Christian faith are no longer relevant to our neighbors. I see already how important Sunday morning worship is for the folks who attend our worship services. However, our neighbors are not joining us because they don't want to join us. They don't have the desire to express and fulfill their spiritual needs the way we do. Singing hymns, absorbing lectures on scripture passages, and partaking in communion rituals are strange, uninteresting customs to them. Here's the hard truth: all the people who want our kind of Christianity are already participating in our church ministries. Our congregations are not going to get any bigger. No advertising campaign, no charismatic young

pastor, no aftermath of a horrible national tragedy will bring more people into our churches to worship as we do, or study the Bible as we do, or participate in charity projects like we do. We are it. And we are no spring chickens.

Our situation is not unique. Indeed, most of our UM churches in the greater northwest area face the same reality we do. Aging congregations, and older, irrelevant (to younger folks) expressions of Christianity mean most of our churches are on a path toward closure. The question before us is, if we can't "grow" our existing congregations, can we develop new ministries that are relevant to our neighbors, making the love and grace of God that already is present in our neighborhoods more visible and real?

Please hear me clearly: **one** facet of our future as United Methodists in Idaho Falls is the ministry of care and support for the saints of our churches. Our saints have given their time, energy and resources to the ministries of our churches for decades, and we must provide them with the care and support they need in the latter part of their lives. This is the Christian thing to do.

However, this cannot be the main or only ministry we engage in. God is calling us to be and do more. This year we are going to explore, experiment, and research new forms of ministry that might lead us into our new future. We will start by meeting our neighbors. Not to ask them to come to "our" church, but to find out what God is doing in their lives. We want to partner with God in whatever God's new plans are for folks in Idaho Falls. Sounds scary, right? It is. But with God's help, all things are possible. I think this is enough "real talk" for now. May God strengthen us for the journey ahead.
