



# **Habitat House Progress**



At the habitat house, the front porch is getting the ceiling and siding.

Inside all the insulation is done on the exterior walls upstairs and downstairs. Sheet rock can start next. If you want to volunteer to help the Sheetrock crew, please contact the Habitat office or stop by the house and let them know when you are available.



#### **Homeless Services**

In October there were 166 homeless services supplied in the 18 days we were open. This represented services to 57 unique people. The services provided included 124 showers, 53 loads of laundry, and 15 requests for supplies. The supplies included 8 sleeping bags, 2 pairs of socks, pastoral care with Ryan. Documentation, and 3 days of WIFI to study for class. The clients ranged in age from 23 to 73 with an average 46. Time in the church varied from 1 min. to 276 minutes with an average of 42 minutes. 14 visitors were new clients for us. 61% have cellphones and 91% have valid ID.
