

## **Homeless Services**

In December there were 97 homeless services supplied in the 12 days we were open. This represented services to 35 unique people. The services provided included 83 showers, and 24 loads of laundry. We also gave away some hygiene kits and provided pastoral counseling. The clients ranged in age from 10 to 72 with an average age of 47. Time in the church varied from 2 min. to 165 minutes with an average of 35 minutes. 2 visitors were new clients for us. 70% have cellphones and 90% have valid ID
