

We may need assistance in providing transportation during the three weeks of camps in July. Call Betty at 208-521-3039



#### **Homeless Services**

In June there were 145 homeless services supplied in the 17 days we were open. This represented services to 51 unique persons. The services provided included 118 showers, 38 loads of laundry, and 15 requests for supplies. The supplies included emergency food, hygiene kits, sleeping bag, socks, underwear, gas, mail and computer use. The clients ranged in age from 18 to 74 with an average age of 44.7. Time in the church varied from 1 min to 170 minutes with an average of 38 minutes. 17 visitors were new clients for us. 72% have cellphones and 88% had valid ID.

Our goal is to see that all students that wish to go to camp can participate. We urge each congregation to donate to a camp fund and fundraise to cover costs.
