The "Every Member Enrichment Event", held March 9, was a great Saturday. Ten members from the Trinity UWF participated.

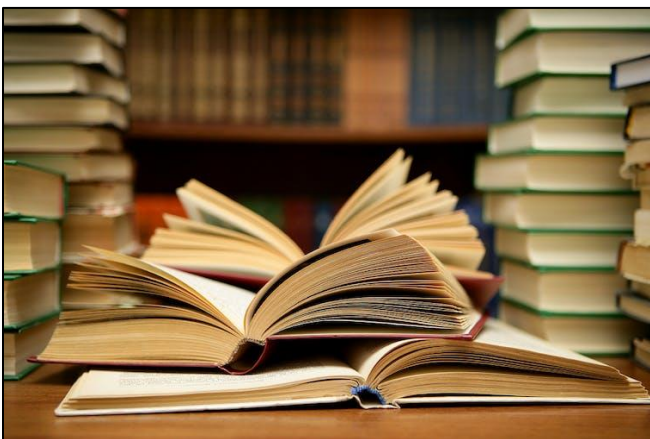

Two scholarships are available:

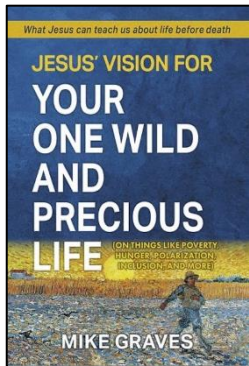
1. The Hazel Skelton General Scholarship: one scholarship, up to \$1,000

## Lamb of God performance

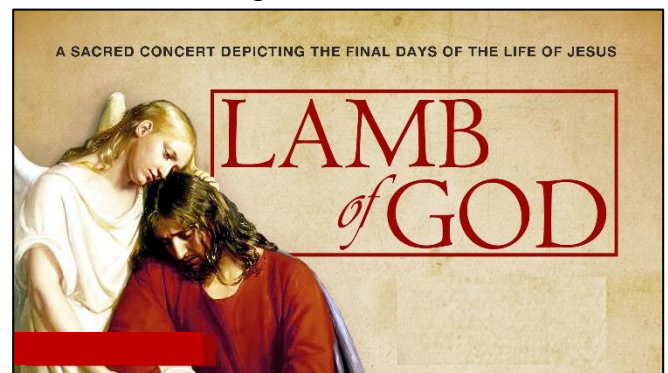

## Homeless Services

In February there were 125 homeless services supplied in the 17 days we were open. This represented services to 36 unique people. The services provided included 100 showers, 22 loads of laundry, and 5 requests for supplies. The supplies included non-skid shoes, ramen noodles, mac & cheese, socks, and underwear. We also helped clients with getting IDs and Birth Certificates. The clients ranged in age from 14 to 73 with an average age of 49. Time in the church varied from 1 min. to 133 minutes with an average of 37 minutes. Most were returning clients, with 4 new clients. 53% have cellphones and 78% have valid ID.

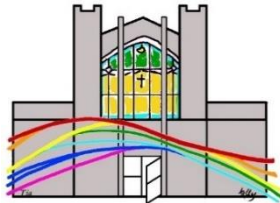

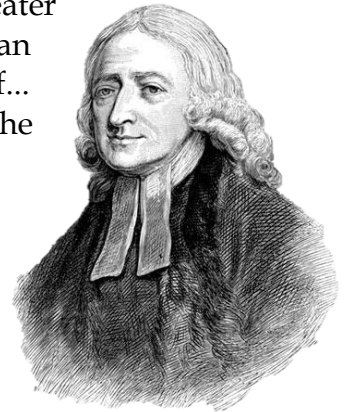
