***When and What is Rally Day?***

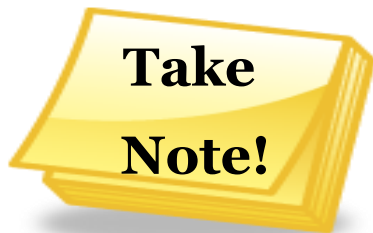
