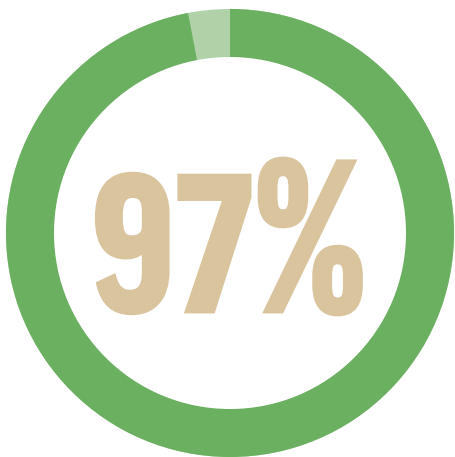

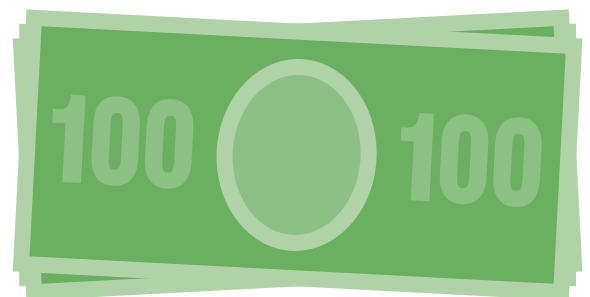

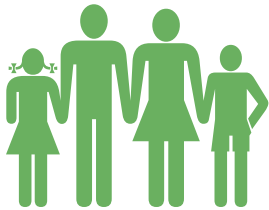
FOOD DRIVE PARTNERS: HELPING TO SOLVE HUNGER

The **Community Food Basket Idaho Falls** is focused on acquiring and distributing food that is not only nutritious, but also provides our families with flexibility in stretching their limited food supply and budget. We want to address food insecurity and hunger as well as attack health disparities among our families in need.

We have initiated a needs-based, evidence-driven approach to the menu of food that we offer that focuses on shelf stable protein such as peanut butter, canned tuna, canned chicken, canned beans, chili and beef stew. Staples such as rice, pasta, whole grain cereals, eggs and shelf-stable boxed milk are also included. Canned fruit is also an important supplement to the limited amount of fresh produce we are able to provide. We want to contribute to the health and well-being of the families that we serve, and not just provide empty calories.

To that end, we ask the various partners who support our efforts by hosting food drives to encourage their donors to clear their pantries or shop for very specific food items that help us distribute healthier choices to the families that we serve.

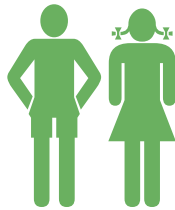

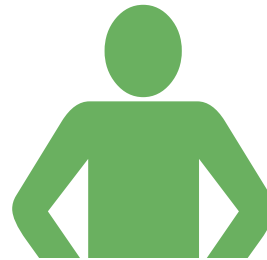
